Project Setup

- I chose a **fictional or partially autobiographical person**
- My scrapbook follows **one person from before birth through death**
- I am using a **digital scrapbook (preferred)** or a physical one
- If digital, I explored the **ScholarForge Scrapbook tool** (free to use)

Required Pages (All Must Be Included)

Opening Page

- **Letter from a parent (mother or father) to the unborn child**
- Written from the **parent's perspective**
- Reflects emotions, hopes, fears, or expectations

Life Stages

Each stage includes **both** an artifact **and** a journal entry.

1. Pre-Natal

2. Infancy

3. Toddlerhood

4. Preschool Years

Final Page

- Obituary
- Written from the **perspective of loved ones**
- Reflects major life events and overall legacy

Content Quality Check

- Each journal entry connects to **developmental psychology concepts**
- Writing shows **growth and change over time**
- Perspectives shift correctly (parent → self → loved ones)
- Artifacts clearly relate to the life stage

Final Review

- All pages are labeled and in order
- Writing is clear and thoughtful
- Scrapbook is ready to submit
