

Student Psychology Trading Card Assignment

What is this assignment?

You will create **one psychology trading card** featuring an important psychologist. The card should look and feel like a sports trading card, but instead of stats, it teaches psychology.

Why are we doing this?

This activity helps you learn the major figures in psychology early in the course. You will not only design a card, but also **explain why your psychologist is important** to classmates.

Your Responsibilities

- Research your assigned psychologist
- Create a clear, accurate trading card
- Be ready to explain why this psychologist matters to the field of psychology

Classroom Activity Day

On the assigned day, you will walk around the room with your card. Other students will select your card and ask you to explain why your psychologist is important. You will do the same with other students' cards.

You are not trading cards — you are teaching psychology.

What Success Looks Like

A strong card is accurate, easy to understand, visually clear, and helps classmates remember the psychologist later in the year.

Bring your card to class on the assigned day. Be prepared to talk.
